#### Whole School Messages:

- Staff are now entering the amount of minutes students are late to lessons, once this has been looked at a group of the worst offenders in each year group will receive detentions of up to an hour. More information to follow, you've been warned.
- Far too many students borrow ties, can any student who still borrows a tie ensure they buy a new one from either Khalsa's or the school office. Parents of repeat offenders will receive phone calls and letters.
- A cyber bullying information leaflet is being placed on the website. This is also available in the waiting area at the front of the school.
- As you know a small number of students have been setting off the fire alarm. This is incredibly disruptive to everyone, especially the Year 11 and 13 students who are stressed about their GCSE and A-Level exams. Students who set off the alarm have received a 5 day external exclusion and the possibility of looking at moving to a different school. All fire alarms are covered by CCTV cameras, you will not get away with it so do not even think about setting them off.

#### Year Team Messages:

- On Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March the school is running its first D.E.A.R Day. This stands for 'Drop Everything and Read'. During Period 2 on this day students will read a book for pleasure in silence within their normal lesson. Students should bring a suitable and age dependant book to school on this day.
